Others (our pediatrician between them) claim that no one really varies the chickenpox for the second time was badly diagnosed for the first time. It is now now Decades later, and about two weeks after me, myself, treated an adult with chickenpox. Guess what? I covered a spread class of "dew drop on a pink petal" injuries. For your doctor who has never seen in a varicella case in the practice of him: get real. To those who propose the theory two viruses: some quotes, please. Varicella twice? Betcha! I had them when I was ten. I had contracted them by my younger brother. I had a moderate case and was well within 2 weeks. About 5 days ago both my son and I started breaking out and went to the doctor and yes, it's chicken. My MD told me that it is more common than most people think. Usually it is due to a weakened immune system and that the first movement around the body has not developed full immunity. Oh, and for the chronicle, my son also had the varicella vaccine, which is supposed to protect the user from Varicella, who obviously didn't. Depending on which study is the failure rate of the vaccine is everywhere between 2% and 60%! This is a huge margin of error ... even a little disturbing of this we are giving our children vaccines with such inconclusive results? Things like this burn me ... Herpes Zoster is not varicella. It is herpes zoster. First diagnosis of my son of Varicella was 6 months. This first varicella was very serious. He had it throughout the body. He has a couple of scars on his face as a try. And today, at the age of 12 he has a more mild case. The first diagnosis of him does not think he was wrong, because he had the chicken chicken's cousins at the same time. The three of him got from the oldest cousin. And the odds that 3 doctors could seem unlikely. I'm just worried that the immune systems of him is weak. And if there is something to worry about. It is more common than everyone thinks? I hope so. I just started working as a health care provider in pediatrics and received my blood-work results for the various immunities.
