Deleting your Facebook search history is a relatively quick and straightforward process. Can I delete individual items from my search history? Yes, you can. To delete individual items, simply follow the first three steps in this guide but instead of clicking Clear Searches, click on the three dot icon next to anything you've searched. Then just click Delete to get rid of it. Who can see my Facebook search history? Your search history is private, meaning only you can see it. However, if someone has access to your device or account, they may also be able to see what you've been searching. Remove a search from activity log: Click profile picture > Settings & privacy > Activity Log > Search History > > Delete. Delete entire search history: Click profile picture > Settings & privacy > Activity Log > Search History > Clear Searches > OK. This article explains how to delete your Activity Log on Facebook from the desktop Facebook app or website, including how to delete one item at a time and how to clear your entire history. Facebook keeps a record of all your past searches and various activities on the site in the Activity Log, which is accessed through your account settings on the Facebook website. If you accidentally searched for something you didn't mean to, you want to remove the record of some activities from your history, or if you're trying to make Facebook more private, you can remove any individual activity from the Activity Log whenever you want. Here's how to remove a search from the Facebook Activity Log: Click your profile picture in the upper right corner. Click Settings & privacy. Click Activity Log. Click Search history. You can also click other items in this list to remove other activity types. Click (three horizontal dots) next to the item you want to remove. Click Delete. Repeat steps 6-7 to remove additional items. There is no way to clear your entire Facebook Activity Log at once. You can clear the entire search history and video history at once, but most of the items in the Activity Log need to be removed one at a time. To completely clear your entire Activity Log, you can clear your entire search and video watch histories with one click each, and then use the method from the previous section to remove other activities individually. Here's how to clear your entire search history on Facebook: You can see posts and comments in your log, but you can't remove or mass delete Facebook posts from there. Instead, you need to perform that task with the Manage Posts function that can be found on your profile page. Click your profile picture in the upper right corner. Click Settings & privacy. Click Activity Log. Click Videos you've watched. Click Clear Video Watch History. Click Home. Click Search History. You're the only one who can see your Activity Log, which means you don't need to worry about anyone crawling through your log to see what you've done on Facebook over the years. However, many of the activities the Activity Log tracks can show up on your timeline for all to see. If you want to prevent anyone from seeing any of that information at all, then you can adjust your Facebook privacy settings to hide specific activities from prying eyes. FAQ Go to your Profile > Settings & privacy > Activity Log > Groups. Communities, Events, and Reels > Group membership activity > three dots next to the thing you want to remove > Delete your activity. The steps for deleting your Activity Log in the Facebook mobile app are basically the same. Clearing this and your activity log regularly is a great way to ensure that your privacy is protected even if you have any unauthorized logins. For this, well show you how to delete your search history on Facebook, among the other options on your account's Activity Log. Your Facebook search history information is hidden behind several menus that aren't really obvious. Your search history is used by the Facebook algorithm to better tune the results whenever you search for anything. If you regularly search for familiar terms, the search results will display those first if you look for them often. If you wish to delete your search history though, you can follow these steps: 1. If you're using the Classic Facebook Theme on the front page, click on your profile icon to open the Profile page. Click on Activity Log that's located on the top and inside your photo. On the Activity Log page, refer to the menu on the left. If you cannot find Search History, then click on More to see the hidden options. Click on Search History to display all of your recorded searches. Scrolling up and down will show you all of your existing search history by date. You can delete these individually by choosing a search, clicking on the Edit button on the rightmost part of the bar, then choosing Delete. You will be asked if you want to remove the search, click Remove Search to agree. If you wish to remove your entire search history, click on Clear Searches on the top of the history menu. You'll be asked if you're sure that you want to delete all your searches. Click Clear Searches to confirm. 2. If you're using the New Facebook Theme, click on the down arrow on the upper right corner of the page (near your profile). Choose Activity Log. Look for Search History on the menu to the left. If you can't find it, click on More. The Activity Log, as the title suggests, contains records of all your activity on Facebook. Unless you regularly delete your records, you'll probably find posts dating back to when you first created your Facebook page here. There is currently no way to delete the entirety of your Activity Log, though you can do so individually if you really wish to. This is done by choosing a particular entry on the log, clicking on the edit button on the rightmost part, and choosing to allow it on the timeline, keep it hidden from the timeline, or deleting it entirely. Some of the more interesting activity lists that you may want to browse, either to review the posts for deletion or just to go down memory lane on things that you posted years ago, are: Posts These include all of your past posts, other people's posts that are on your timeline, posts that mention you or tag you, and those that have been hidden from your timeline but are still saved in your activity history. If you've been registered on Facebook for a long time, and are a frequent user, this is going to be a very long list. Photos and Videos These are the images and clips that you posted, tagged, or are in your albums. This will be the place to find old photos and videos that you may have lost due to time. If you regularly upload to Facebook, more often than not they will probably still be here. It's a good idea to give this a log a good once over if only to make sure that you don't have photos from your college days still floating about. Security and Login Information Not as comprehensive as the other logs, the Security and Login information page contains a record of the devices that have logged onto your account. This may be a way to find out if others have been able to enter your account without you knowing. The record doesn't go too far back though, and some of them list only the IP addresses of the devices that logged in. However, if you suspect a hacking attempt, looking through here for clues is as good a start as any. Although the search history helps you easily find the items that you usually look for, having that data stay on Facebook is usually not a good idea. Regularly clearing your search history and your Activity Log in general keeps your data safe from any potential hacks. Do you have other tips on how to delete your search history on Facebook?
