Punch-Out!! cheats and codes for NES, as well as tips and secrets, including passwords, Game Genie codes, and Action Replay codes. **###ENDARTICLE** Little Mac is the underdog hero who manages to defeat countless foes and become a champion in the Punch-Out!! series, which was heavily influenced by Mike Tyson's popularity at the time of its release. Little Mac is a 17-year-old boxer from the Bronx with a lion heart, but he is often portrayed as a small, skinny fighter wearing signature green shorts and boxing gloves. The original game featured an older-looking boxer with green hair referred to as 'Challenge,' but Nintendo developed a backstory for Little Mac and his trainer, Doc Louis. The arcade games showcased memorable challengers such as Glass Joe, King Hippo, and others who presented unique boxing styles that needed to be solved. To cater to a global audience, especially children, Nintendo re-imaged some characters when Mike Tyson's Punch-Out!! was released globally. This included changing the Russian boxer from Vodka Drunkenki to Soda Popinski, altering Piston Honda and King Hippo's complexions from pinkish skin to mustard yellow color. The game is divided into three main circuits - Minoru, Major, and World Circuits - with a fourth hidden circuit called Another World Circuit that can be accessed by inputting a special passcode. The fourth circuit has only appeared in Mike Tyson's Punch-Out!! and is game over if Little Mac loses any of the matches. The inclusion of Mike Tyson in the game was a result of Nintendo's founder Minoru Arakawa attending a boxing event featuring future heavyweight champion, Mike Tyson. Arakawa signed Tyson to a three-year deal, allowing Nintendo to use his name and likeness for the American version. However, when Tyson's deal ended, Nintendo decided not to renew it, replacing him with Mr. Dream. Mike Tyson's Punch-Out!! is forever synonymous with the boxer, who became a difficult final boss to defeat due to his undefeated record in the ring during the game's peak. Despite Tyson himself having yet to play Mike Tyson's Punch-Out!! until 2013, he was filmed playing the game for promotional purposes and could not get past Glass Joe. The game also features cameos from other Nintendo characters, such as Mario, who was originally intended to be removed but ended up being included as a joke. Referee Mario only appeared in Mike Tyson's Punch-Out!! before being replaced by a generic referee in subsequent titles. Interestingly, the original NES game Golf featured a precursor version of Mike Tyson's Punch-Out!!, which was produced for a golf tournament and never planned for public release. However, due to high demand, the game was later released, and the gold cartridges featuring this version have become highly valuable due to their rarity. **##ENDARTICLE** How Nintendo Used Mike Tyson's Name to Boost Game Sales Nintendo America's president Arakawa was inspired by Mike Tyson's boxing skills at a live match, deciding that using his name would boost the game's popularity. With Tyson's success in the ring, the game's profits skyrocketed. **###GAME SECRETS AND CODES** When facing Bald Bull in the Major Circuit Title match, start by timing a body shot when he unleashes his Bull Charge. For your second match against Bald Bull, knock him down once during the round before his bull charge. Hit him with a body shot at the right moment, and he should fall to the ground. Repeat this process one more time to win the match and the Major Circuit Title. If you face Bald Bull again, try knocking him down only once using a star-punch. He might "freeze" occasionally, allowing you to get an additional free punch. You can also quickly cut off his right cross with a left jab to the face. After the first knockdown, he will freeze, so save your star-punch for later. When fighting Bald Bull for the second time, use your star-punch strategically. Save it until you're sure you can get another knockdown. Timing is crucial; if done well, you might win by TKO in just one round. Another match you'll face is against Don Flamenco. His first move will be to taunt you; punch him back and wait for his uppercut demonstration. Dodge the uppercut and give him a combination of lefts and rights for an easy KO. While fighting Don Flamenco, dodge his straight punch and quickly strike at his stomach to earn a star. After knocking him down, wait for his big cross; interrupt it with a left jab just as he raises his arm, earning another star-punch. Let him throw the big cross after recovering, then hit him once in the face before unleashing the star-punch. Against Don Flamenco's second match, be cautious - he has new moves that make him harder to defeat. Dodge his straight punch and use your lefts and rights until he uses his across jab. After dodging the jab, punch him directly. Remember to dodge his taunt and uppercut, and then continue with a combination of punches. During Don Flamenco's fights, you can also earn star-punches by striking at his stomach when he prepares for his left jab. If timed correctly, this might lead to enough star-punches for a TKO in the first round. Lastly, face Glass Joe and keep giving him upper shots. Watch how he changes his guard based on the direction of the D-pad you're holding. Hit him where he's not blocking, potentially earning a star. Another strategy is to wait until he taunts you, then punch him in the gut before finishing him off. defeat great tiger by watching for his emerald in turban blink on and off, then punch his face quickly to get a star, followed by an uppercut move. Repeat this until he falls three times for a quick tko; alternatively, watch the emerald in turban during first round, punch his face when it turns on and off, then do uppercut move repeatedly until he falls. To take Mike Tyson down, focus on whittling his energy away from about half by the 1:30 mark. In round 1, use one or two punches to hit him, then dodge his next punch. Get him within a punch or two of going down and come out with a quick punching rhythm - like body-body-head-body or head-body-body-head. Find a rhythm that works for you, but be aware he becomes predictable after the first round. Just dodge his three-punch combo and unleash on him as if he's an easy opponent. Repeat this strategy in most of round 2, but if you get a star, it gets even easier. You can knock him out or get a quick K.O. by hitting him when he winks at the 1:30 mark. However, if he doesn't go down, he'll unleash a devastating uppercut. In round 3, be aware that he does everything from round 2 and is just as vulnerable to those tactics. He's also extremely unpredictable, so you must be careful and ready to dodge at all times. When he's knocked down in round 3, quickly come back with punches, especially his medium punch. Dodge his uppercut and unleash a combination when he throws one. The key technique here is timing your dodges perfectly to expend Tyson's energy. Press the left button to dodge, then quickly move back to the right after he misses you. This glitch will put you in punching form and allow you to get multiple hits on him. Be careful not to "dodge back" too soon or get punched. If you wear Tyson down in round 1, he'll have all his energy for round 2. Wear him down again to just before the knockout and dodge the at the top of round two to get an early knockdown. Sometimes this leads to a round 2 TKO; otherwise, it's a TKO in round three or a win by decision. The most challenging part is dealing with Tyson's speed and blocking during round 1. Any mistakes will result in failure, so be precise when using the strategy that involves timing your punches. For instance, if Tyson throws a punch from the left or right, you must dodge it first and then counter with a 1-2 combination. Avoid Piston Honda's Uppercuts with Timing Dodge his uppercut after the half-second delay, immediately counterattack, then follow up with a stomach punch series. Watch for Piston Rush and time your punch perfectly before he reaches you to land a one-hit KO. Dodge Soda Popinski's slow-moving punches and power uppercuts; punch him directly without strategy. Be cautious of Super Macho Man's twist punches; dodge his initial jabs, then counterattack, watch out for the spin punch, and dodge subsequent ones before landing a decisive blow. Unload on Slowpoker after dodging his slow uppercuts and hooks, wait for his medium spin punch setup, attack his head to maximize star earnings, and land your super punch when possible. Easy win: To get an easy win, attack two or more times. Then just watch until you see him blinking red and move to the left. Swap him by rapidly pressing Up + A about six times, then he will block. Keep repeating this until he is out. Prepare during the round to K.O. a fighter early next round by getting a given fighter within a punch or two of going down. Then, he gets too close. Try to keep him at a distance and look for an opening to land a hit. Knockout retry (emulator): Note: This trick may only be done if the game is played on the NESTicle emulator. Select "CPU", "NES Movie", and "Record" to capture your match. If your boxer is knocked out, play the movie and stop a few seconds before your boxer is knocked out. The emulator will start the game exactly at the point where it was stopped, allowing you to avoid the mistake that lead to the knock out. A peculiar glitch allows players to regain some health by repeatedly pressing A and B when knocked down. By timing this correctly, particularly on specific rounds or against certain opponents, players can recover more of their lost health. In the Minor Circuit, getting up on an even number yields extra health, whereas in the Major Circuit, doing so at 7, 8, or 9 grants additional health, potentially full health against King Hippo. Against Mike Tyson, regaining health on the ninth count is usually successful except for the third attempt. Interestingly, pressing select before the fight begins can cause Little Mac to lose health, but doing so during Doc Louis's pre-fight pep talk will restore it. Contributors have also discovered ways to manipulate gameplay. For instance, pressing A+B+Select on a specific number yields a unique effect, such as in Another World Circuit or when fighting Don Flamenco. Selecting and then pressing select or shift before round one can affect health gain during Doc Louis's pep talks, adding a layer of strategy to the game. Furthermore, players have found ways to exploit glitches to their advantage. In the second fight against Piston Honda, scoring only one punch is possible by dodging his attacks and timing a single hit perfectly. Against Don Flamenco, hitting him immediately after he taunts yields an easy victory in the first round. Timing is crucial as the charging time for Piston Honda's Piston Punch routine is significantly shorter. Lastly, pressing 'Select' rapidly before the second or third round starts can lower damage taken and provide some health restoration. Hint: Defeating Bald Bull in the World Circuit When fighting Bald Bull in the World Circuit, he will be a little faster. Practice your finger speed and use the same tactics as in the Major Circuit fight with him. Dodge his punches and occasionally hit him. When he uses his Bull Charge, jab him in the stomach when he gets close. At the start of the game where it says "New" and "Continue", do not press any buttons. Wait for the scene to appear of a fight with the CPU controlling Mac. If you watch, you will see a strategy for defeating Bald Bull the second time. Hint: Defeating Don Flamenco (first fight) Don Flamenco will start by taunting you. If you try punching at this point, he will block it. Hint: Defeating Don Flamenco (second fight) Don Flamenco is much more difficult to defeat the second time around as he will demonstrate two more moves - a straight punch and an across jab. He should start out with the straight punch. Dodge those and hit him a couple of times. Next, he will use his across jab. Dodge that and punch him. After that, he will taunt you, then perform an uppercut. Dodge that and give him left and right attacks. He will not get punch drunk for the entire series of punches as before. Just keep moving and punching. Hint: Defeating Glass Joe When you start the fight with Glass Joe, just keep giving him upper shots. Hold Up or Down and you will notice that he changes his guard very slowly to block which direction the Directional Pad is held. Hit him where he is not blocking and you may get a star. One shot of the Super Punch (press Start when you have a star) and he will go down. Another way to defeat him is to wait a short time until he taunts you. When he rushes towards you, give him a punch to the gut and he will go down. After he has been knocked down, if you wait 40 seconds, he will jump back and taunt you. When he comes back down, hit him in the face. 60% of the time he will stay down. However, if you want to be sure, hit him with the left. Hint: Defeating Great Tiger Great Tiger's form is similar to Von Kaiser. Watch the emerald in his turban. Before he punches, it should blink on and off. Punch his face at this point. When he starts performing his uppercuts, use a lower body punch when he bends down to get a star. Sometimes he will get mad and use his tiger flash attack, spinning around in circles. Block his repeated punches. If you block every one, his head will spin. Hit him in the face for a one-hit knock down. Repeat this to win. Hint: Defeating King Hippo When King Hippo opens his mouth it means he is about to punch you. He should shake violently when he is about to deliver that punch. While his mouth is open, quickly jab him in the face. He should grab his mouth and drop his trunks and you should see a little bandage that resembles an X. Hint: Defeating Mike Tyson Mike ##ARTICLE To defeat Mr. Sandman, pay close attention to his entrance and be aware of his strong uppercuts. He will perform straight punches, so dodge/block these and don't try to hit him while he's doing them. Sooner or later, he'll switch to across punches. Punch him in the face at this point, then continue jabbing him in the stomach. You can't keep jabbing him in the face because he'll block it. After a while, he may start using his uppercuts. When he starts flashing, get out of the way because he's about to perform one of these. Keep dodging as soon as you get back to your original position three times. Hit him with left and right attacks again and you should get an easy KO. Hint: Defeating Don Flamenco (second fight) Don Flamenco is much more difficult to defeat the second time around as he will demonstrate two more moves - a straight punch and an across jab. He should start out with the straight punch. Dodge those and hit him a couple of times. Next, he will use his across jab. Dodge that and punch him. After that, he will taunt you, then perform an uppercut. Dodge that and give him left and right attacks. He will not get punch drunk for the entire series of punches as before. Just keep moving and punching. Hint: Defeating Glass Joe When you start the fight with Glass Joe, just keep giving him upper shots. Hold Up or Down and you will notice that he changes his guard very slowly to block which direction the Directional Pad is held. Hit him where he is not blocking and you may get a star. One shot of the Super Punch (press Start when you have a star) and he will go down. Another way to defeat him is to wait a short time until he taunts you. When he rushes towards you, give him a punch to the gut and he will go down. After he has been knocked down, if you wait 40 seconds, he will jump back and taunt you. When he comes back down, hit him in the face. 60% of the time he will stay down. However, if you want to be sure, hit him with the left. Hint: Defeating Great Tiger Great Tiger's form is similar to Von Kaiser. Watch the emerald in his turban. Before he punches, it should blink on and off. Punch his face at this point. When he starts performing his uppercuts, use a lower body punch when he bends down to get a star. Sometimes he will get mad and use his tiger flash attack, spinning around in circles. Block his repeated punches. If you block every one, his head will
