His desire to save Tasha, which he spends a lot of the pilot trying to do, almost makes Tariq a protagonist worth championing. But after six seasons of making this kid an arrogant brat who assassinated the show's star and previously got his twin sister Raina (Donshea Hopkins) killed, this soapy drama full of unintentionally comedic moments has a lot of heavy lifting ahead. Clearly series creator Courtney A. Kemp and her writers know how daunting it will be to turn Tariq into a sweetheart as proven by the need to introduce new characters who are more appealing. This includes a very charismatic defense attorney named David MacLean (the always enjoyable Cliff "Method Man" Smith), who vows to set Tasha free, and a criminal matriarch named Monet (Mary J. Blige). Melanie Liburd ("This is Us") costars as Tariq's college advisor/professor Carrie Milgram, a woman who sees the good in Tariq when no one else can. Carrie tries to get Tariq into a special curriculum despite his inability to finish the required reading, *Albert Camus' "The Stranger"*.
