In my experience, I've become aware that one must possess a high school diploma/GED in order to work as a CPhT. Sorry, pasqie. Unfortunately Walgreens does not allow anyone under the age of 18 to step foot into the pharmacy regardless of state law. I had to start there at the front register for that reason myself. Once I turned 18 they changed my position to pharmacy technician. While there aren't many retail stores that hire employees under 18, there are some major chains that hire teenagers. From clothing stores to food service locations, stores like Forever 21, Gap, JCPenney, Kroger, Panera Bread, and more hire teens to work in-store. Some clothing stores also hire models for their brand, primarily through modeling agencies like Future Faces NYC and Next Model Management. Labor Laws for Minors When looking for a job as a teenager, keep in mind that most states typically require minors to obtain a work permit with the help of a legal parent/guardian. The Department of Labor lists the states that require minors to have a work permit and/or an age certificate. Also, most stores only have a few slots open for younger employees — partially because minors can only work limited hours — while other stores only hire teens as seasonal employees. Note: Retail jobs for minors typically pay minimum wage. So, getting employed as a technician is an easier role to obtain — at least at the present time. Pharmacy Tech Salaries According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, a pharmacy technician makes about \$13 per hour, on average, in retail establishments. If you work in a hospital pharmacy, you will usually average about \$16.00 per hour. Pharmacy Errors With that being said, there are some notable risks associated with pharmaceutical inexperience. While a pharmacy usually has double and triple-check processes in place, a pharmacist may not always catch an error that his or her technician may have made. Unfortunately, these kinds of mistakes can be serious when caused as the result of inexperience, lack of skills, or immaturity. Types of Errors Errors can be made due to the following: Dispensing the incorrect medication Calculating an incorrect dosage Distributing the incorrect medical equipment Giving incorrect advice to a patient or customer So, if you want to work as a technician, you need to have excellent pharmacy math skills. That means you have to enjoy subjects such as algebra or chemistry. If you have problems understanding the subject matter of these types of subjects, then you need to hone your skills so you have a complete understanding of how to calculate and dispense medicines. Older customers sometimes are leery when they are served by a teen in a pharmacy. So, you also need to be aware of this reality if you plan to apply at your local drug store as an intern in the pharmacy. An Example of One Serious Technician Error Once in point about the seriousness of making an error was reported on ABC News. A Florida appeals court upheld a judgment against the pharmacy retailer Walgreen for a \$25.8 million judgment. The error of a teen pharmacy technician led to a patient receiving blood thinner pills in an amount that was ten times greater than what had been prescribed. This case underscored the use of pharmacy technicians who have not yet graduated from high school. During court testimony, the technician stated she typed ten milligrams on a patient's prescription instead of the required dose of one milligram. Basic Pharmacy Tech Skills Therefore, you can work in a pharmacy, even if you are as young as 17 years of age. However, you also need to understand that this type of role carries an important responsibility with respect to patient safety. Again, it is important that you have an excellent understanding of pharmacy math and that you also have superior communication skills. It won't do you any good to lie about your availability. Tell me about a time when you had to deal with a difficult customer and what was the outcome? Why are they asking? When it comes to life in customer service, you will come across your share of upset or difficult customers. If you have prior work experience, they might ask you this question to see how you dealt with the situation because it does come up, and you need to handle it in the best way possible. What's the ideal answer? If you don't have any experiences with difficult customers, that's okay. If you have, tell them the story (if you handled it well, and it had a positive outcome). If the situation ended up with you screaming and yelling or getting fired, that's not a story you want to share. They want to hear that you did your best to make the difficult customer happy. Or, if you couldn't fix the problem, you grabbed a manager and had them help you. Why should we hire you? Why are they asking? If a manager asks you this question, they are trying to get you to sell yourself. They are wanting to find out how well you can communicate, while being positive and professional. What's the ideal answer? Know your strengths. If you get asked this question, tell them how you will benefit their business. They want to hear that you have above average verbal communication skills, have a friendly and upbeat demeanor, and can successfully sign up new members to their Balance rewards program. Tell them that you are a reliable worker who will show up on time for every scheduled shift. If you are interested in a career with the company, definitely let them know.
