Instead choose from one of several online file conversion tools that allow you to convert your JPG to PDF format. The conversion process only takes a minute, and you'll be able to immediately download your PDF file, either on the website or through your email. Visit the Free JPG to PDF website (see Resources for link). Click on "Choose File." Select the JPG image you want to convert to PDF. Click "Convert." Wait a few moments for the conversion to complete. Choose "Download PDF" on the confirmation screen. The PDF begins downloading to your hard drive. Visit Neva's website (see Resources for link). Choose "PDF" as your output format. Click on "Choose File" and select your JPG file. Choose "Upload and Convert." Click "Download" when the conversion finishes. You need a paid subscription to Adobe Acrobat Pro (there's a free trial) to complete the process. This article explains how to convert PDF documents to PowerPoint slides using the Adobe PDF to PowerPoint conversion tool in Adobe Acrobat both online and within a PDF document. There are many reasons to convert a PDF file to a PowerPoint presentation. It could be as simple as creating a presentation from an existing document, or you may want to edit and add to the content in the PDF document to make a presentation. Whatever the reason, the easiest way to convert PDF to PPT is to use Adobe's online conversion tool. The online conversion tool from Adobe is not free to use. You may be able to access it using a free trial, but you'll have to sign up for the service or lose access to your documents once the trial is over. Go to the Adobe Convert PDF to PowerPoint tool online. Click Select a file. Navigate to and select the file you want to convert from PDF to PowerPoint, and then click Open. The upload area will change to display a message that the file is first uploading and then converting. There's nothing for you to do but wait for the tool to complete. When the conversion is complete, a preview of the PowerPoint file is displayed, and you'll get a prompt to sign in with Adobe, Google, or Apple. Enter the appropriate information to sign in. Once you're signed in, locate the file in the list of Recent documents and click the three-dot menu at the right end of the file information line. You may also see a listing for the file in the upper right corner of the page. If that's the case, you can simply click Download from there to download the file to your hard drive. In the menu that appears, click the Download button to download the file to your computer. One thing to keep in mind when you're converting files from PDF to PPT is that they may not always convert perfectly, especially for graphics-heavy files, like the one used in this example. You can also create a PowerPoint file from a PDF is from within the PDF file. Find and open the file you want to convert, and then follow these instructions. In the PDF document, click Export PDF. The file you have open should already appear in the Select PDF File text field in the menu that appears. Select the Convert to: Dropdown menu and choose Microsoft PowerPoint. Click Convert. If you don't already have a subscription to Adobe Acrobat Pro, you'll get a prompt to sign up for one. There is a short free trial that you can use. If you already have a subscription to Acrobat Pro, or once you've signed up for the free trial, the file will begin converting. Once the conversion is complete, you can click Save As and save the file to your hard drive or click View Converted Files to view the file online. If you opt to try the Adobe Acrobat Pro free trial to convert your PDF to a PowerPoint document, don't forget to cancel the free trial before it ends so you don't get charged for it. Windows: Right-click on the PNG file and select Print > Microsoft Print to PDF > Print > name the file > Save. Mac: Open the image in the Preview app. Select File > Export > PDF > name the file and select the file location. The steps below work with any image file and any program that has a Print function. Alternatively, you can use it from the Print command in the context menu. Select the PNG file and right-click to choose Print from the context menu. Select Microsoft Print to PDF as the printer and click Print. Another dialog box will appear where you can enter the File name and select the file location. Once done, click Save. You can use Microsoft Print to PDF to even combine multiple PNG images into a single PDF. Pick a layout from the options on the right before you select Print. Save the PDF to any location of your choice. If you don't see the Print option in the context menu, use any program which has a Print function. Select Microsoft Print to PDF in the list of printers. Like Windows, macOS has an in-built feature in the Preview app to handle all PNG to PDF conversions. Open the image you'd like to convert with the Preview app. Select File > Export as PDF. Type a file name or use the default and Save the file to a location of your choice. The Photoshop PDF format can save Photoshop data, such as layers, alpha channels, notes, and spot color. You can open this PDF file in Photoshop and continue your edits. Versions of Photoshop before CS2 will open this as a generic PDF file, and editing data won't be preserved. Open the PNG file in Photoshop. Choose File > Save As. Opt to save the file in your Creative Cloud account or the desktop. If you choose the desktop, the standard Save as dialog box will open. Select Photoshop PDF from the Save as type dropdown menu. Select Save. In the Save Adobe PDF dialog box, select an Adobe PDF preset. Printing presets help Photoshop decide how the final document will be used. Desktop printers, commercial printers, or email, etc. are some common printing presets. Select Save PDF. Photoshop creates the PDF document file and saves it in a location of your choice. The Save Adobe PDF dialog has a few more optional settings. These are beyond the scope of this basic guide. Besides Adobe Photoshop, other image editors should also have similar PNG to PDF conversion features as part of their Save dialogs or Export options. Free online PNG to PDF conversion tools are all around you if you don't want to use the above options. Most of them work in the same way. You can upload a single image or a batch of PNG images and then select the conversion button. Some of them also allow you to drag and drop the images, which speeds up your work. Adobe has a fast online PDF conversion tool you can use, but it may require a subscription or free trial if you use it more than one time. Thanks for letting us know! Tell us why! An SVG file is Scalable Vector Graphics file. Open one with any browser or an image tool like Photoshop, Illustrator, or GIMP. Convert to PNG or JPEG using our tool (below) or to other formats with a graphics editor. This article explains what an SVG file is and how the format is different than other image formats, how to open one, and how to convert one to a more common format like PNG or JPG. A file with the SVG file extension is really a text file in its details. Since a Scalable Vector Graphics file is really a text file in its details, you can view the text version of the file in any text editor. See our Best Free Text Editors list for our favorites, but even the default text reader in your operating system would work, like Notepad in Windows. For Saved Game files, the game that created the SVG file most likely uses it automatically when you open the gameplay, which means you probably can't manually open the SVG file through the program's menu. However, even if you do manage to get the SVG file to open through an Open menu of some sort, you have to use the right SVG file that goes with the game that created it. If the game itself won't open the SVG file, try GT2A Saved Game Editor, or open the SVG file in a text editor to see if there's something there that's of use. The easiest way to convert an SVG file to either PNG or JPG, the two most common image formats, is to use our own SVG file converter: Converting an SVG file with an online tool like ours is usually the quickest and easiest way to get your file into the format you want. No need to already have an expensive program installed or to download unfamiliar software. If you need to convert it to a different format, like PDF or GIF, and your SVG is pretty small, then a third-party online tool like Zamzar will do the trick. Autotracer.org is another online SVG converter which lets you convert an SVG (from your device or through its URL) to some other types of formats like EPS, Adobe Illustrator file (AI), DXF, PDF, SK, etc. If you have a larger SVG file, any software programs mentioned above in the How to Open an SVG File section should be able to save/export the SVG file to a new format, too. For example, if you're using Inkscape, after you open/edit the SVG file you can then save it back to SVG with any changes you make, but can also save it to a different file format like PNG, PDF, DXF, ODG, EPS, TAR, PS, HPGL, and many others. The Scalable Vector Graphics format was created in 1999 and is still being developed by the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C). Like you've already read above, the entire contents of an SVG file is just text. If you were to open one in a text editor, you would see only text like in the example above. This is how SVG viewers are able to show the picture—by reading the text and understanding how it should be displayed. Looking at that example, you can see how easy it is to edit the dimensions of the image to make it as large as you want without affecting the quality of the edges or color. Since the instructions for rendering the image can be easily altered in an SVG editor, so too can the image itself. What is the difference between SVG, PNG, and JPG? SVG is a vector-based graphic format that represents images as mathematical values. JPG is a raster or bitmap image format, while PNG uses binary code to compress image data. SVG files are preferred for graphic design because anyone can easily view the intended dimensions of each image element. How do I convert an SVG file to a Microsoft Word document? You can include SVG files in a Microsoft Word document the same way you insert pictures into Word. When you click the SVG image, you can make edits using the Format tab at the top of Word.
