The song was collected and published in 1937 by the nursery rhymes collector Anne Gilchrist in "Journal of the English Folk Dance and Song Society", as she remembered it from her Welsh nurse from the 1870s. Some years before another version of the song was recorded in the "English Folk-Songs for Schools" collection published in 1906 by the Cecil Sharp and Sabine Baring-Gould.
