Download files from Google Drive with a computer, Android or iOS device. Important: If you try to download a suspicious file, you may get a warning message. Use caution if you download the file. To download a file from Google Drive: Go to [drive.google.com](http://drive.google.com). Click a file to download. To download multiple files, press Command (Mac) or Ctrl (Windows) click any other files. Right-click click Download. Tip: You can't drag a file or folder directly to your desktop. Save a file to a different format. When you download a file, you have the option to save the file in a different format, such as: A PDF document (.pdf) Microsoft Word (.docs) PowerPoint (.pptx) A JPEG file (.jpg) Learn how to convert Office and other file types into Docs, Sheets or Slides. If you can't download a file, the owner may have disabled options to print, download or copy for people who only have comment or view access. Blocked third-party cookies can prevent Drive Web downloads. Drive Web uses third-party cookies to communicate with Google's secure download server. Blocking third-party cookies in Chrome will prevent you from downloading through Google Drive. If you want to block third-party cookies and still download from Drive, allow third-party cookies for just Drive. Type `chrome://settings/cookies` in the browser address bar, press Enter. Under 'See all site data and permissions', scroll to the 'Sites allowed to use third-party cookies' section. On the right, click Add. In the 'Add a site' window, enter [drive.google.com](http://drive.google.com). Click Add. Tip: Learn more about changes to third-party cookie requirements in Google Drive. Further troubleshooting: If you still have problems downloading files from Drive, you can: Make sure that third-party cookies are allowed for Drive at `chrome://settings/cookies`. It should say 'Including third-party cookies on this site' below the site exception for [drive.google.com](http://drive.google.com). If it doesn't, click `Bin` to remove the site. Follow steps 2-5 above. Under 'Sites that can never use cookies', make sure there aren't any entries for `googleusercontent.com`, `drive.google.com`, or `google.com`. This prevents downloads from Google Drive. If you find these sites listed, click `Menu` Remove. Turn off all extensions and try to download. If you can download a file, turn the extensions on one at a time to identify any with problems. OBS Studio is officially distributed as a Flatpak on Flathub and a PPA for Ubuntu 24.04 and newer. For other installation methods, including unofficial packages, click here. Flatpak Instructions You can install OBS Studio from Flathub here. If your distro is not already set up to install Flatpaks, you can follow the instructions here. Ubuntu Instructions (24.04+) Run these commands to install OBS Studio on Ubuntu via the official PPA: `sudo add-apt-repository ppa:obsproject/obs-studio` `sudo apt update` `sudo apt install obs-studio` Next: Buy & use a Play gift card You can install apps, games, and digital content on your device from the Google Play Store. Some content is available at no charge, and some you need to buy. You can use apps that you bought on Google Play on any Android device without the need to pay again if each device is signed into the same Google Account. To download an app: Open Google Play. On your Android device, open the Google Play app. On your Computer, go to [play.google.com](http://play.google.com). Search or browse for an app or content. Select an item. Select Install (for no charge items) or the item's price. Tips: To check that an app is reliable, find out what other people say about it. Under the app's title, check the star ratings and the number of downloads. To read individual reviews, scroll to the "Ratings and reviews" section.
