How to reset my jlab bluetooth headphones

Forgetting your JBuds Air device, turn off bluetooth, open charging case door and leave both earbuds inside. You need to press button on ONE earbud 4x times until light turn solid blue. Do same with other earbud. Then you put earbuds back in charging case. Wait till Left earbud turn white. Right earbud blink blue/white. Now your headphones are ready to be paired with bluetooth device. You can pair them when you struggle with connection issues or sound quality problems with new device.
