Earls explains all the changes in their online ad, emphasizing what worked, and what didn't work so much in the "prototype" space. "It gave us the opportunity to test new food and beverage menu products, interior design concepts and other ideas of thought forward. He gave us the opportunity to look to the future, make some forecasts and try them on a restaurant, rather than 67 restaurants," says Earls. New menu items tested at Earls. 67 will head towards other location menus, like some of the design elements, and the sense that even if it is a chain restaurant, not all places must be the exact same - they can have a sense of place. Earls calls this last thing, "take the chain." Also do not attack around: Fruit-based water, separate dining and dinner menus, and a hospitality fee instead of tips. The latter was a six-month experiment that ended several months ago.
