Katy is of course upset but is relieved to not have to go through another divorce, as that was the worst time in her life.” According to the insider, Perry, 40, and Bloom’s split has been “a long time coming” as things between them “have been tense for months.” (The pair, who share 4-year-old daughter Daisy, have been apart since Perry kicked off her Lifestyles tour earlier this year.) For now, Perry is “keeping busy” on tour “and is distracted,” the insider shares, revealing that while on the road, the pop star is “renting out” her Westcott Estate in Montecito, California. 2025 kicked off with a slew of celebrity breakups. Two months after first sparking split rumors, Jessica Simpson announced that she and Eric Johnson had called it quits after 10 years of marriage. “Eric and I have been living separately navigating a painful situation in our marriage,” she told Us Weekly in a January 13 [...] “But her and Orlando have always lived in their other Montecito home as their primary residence,” the source continues, adding that the duo were “planning on making the Westcott home their family home but plans have changed” and “have been living apart since Katy has been on tour.” Katy Perry and Orlando Bloom. The couple briefly split in March 2017, but were back together by February 2018. Her popular singles include “I Kissed a Girl,” “Last Friday Night (T.G.I.F.),” “Roar,” and “Rise.” Katy Hudson was raised in southern California, the middle child of two itinerant born-again Christian ministers. Nonreligious music was forbidden in the Hudson household, and she grew up singing church hymns and gospel tunes. As a teenager, she learned to play the guitar and sought a musical career in Nashville with a Christian record label, but her debut album, the gospel-influenced Katy Hudson (2001), sold poorly. By then, however, Hudson had found new musical models in such rock artists as Freddie Mercury and Alanis Morissette, whom she had discovered through friends. She soon moved to Los Angeles to pursue success in the secular music realm, adopting her mother’s maiden name, Perry, to avoid confusion with the actress Kate Hudson. Perry’s initial efforts at mainstream stardom were fruitless, with two separate record labels signing and subsequently dropping her before any material was released. In 2007, however, Capitol Records put out Perry’s EP Ur So Gay, which attracted modest attention for its cheerfully flippant title track. She made a greater splash several months later with the single “I Kissed a Girl,” an assertive ode to sexual curiosity backed by a hard-edged electro-pop beat. The song quickly stirred controversy, as some critics derided it for promoting same-sex relations and others charged that the racy scenario it depicted catered to male fantasies of female sexuality. Nevertheless, the combination of titillation and polished melodicism helped “I Kissed a Girl” become a number one hit in multiple countries, powering sales for her album One of the Boys (2008). With its bouncy, sharp-tongued second single, “Hot N Cold,” also proving popular, the album—much of which Perry wrote herself—eventually registered sales of more than three million copies in the United States. By late 2009 Perry had become frequent tabloid fodder, largely because of her quirky, vividly colored fashions—which borrowed variously from 1940s pinup models, burlesque performers, and the kawaii (“cute”) cultural aesthetic of Japan—as well as her high-profile relationship with English comedian Russell Brand, to whom she was briefly married (2010–12). After recording the stripped-down live album MTV Unplugged (2009), Perry returned to the studio. The resulting release, Teenage Dream (2010), which provided a broader showcase for her full-throated voice, was even more commercially successful than One of the Boys, spawning such hits as the warm-weather frivolity “California Gurls” (featuring rapper Snoop Dogg) and the inspirational “Firework.” When “Last Friday Night (T.G.I.F.)” reached the top of the Billboard Hot 100 chart in mid-2011, Perry tied Michael Jackson’s record of five number one songs from a single album. Perry maintained her grip on the mainstream with her next release, Prism (2013), which produced, among other hits, the anthemic “Roar.” Her 2016 single “Rise” was featured in television coverage of that year’s Olympic Games in Rio de Janeiro. Perry’s fifth studio album, Witness (2017), more introspective than her earlier work, was less well received. She returned to mainstream pop with the empowerment-oriented Smile (2020). Perry later released 143(2024), which was notable for its negative reviews. While critics often disparaged Perry’s songs as vapid, the music industry was generally kinder, rewarding her with several Grammy Award nominations, including album of the year for Teenage Dream. In 2011 she made her big-screen acting debut, providing the voice of Smurfette in the film The Smurfs, and she reprised the role for a 2013 sequel. She was also the subject of the 3-D concert-tour documentary Katy Perry: Part of Me (2012). From 2018 to 2024 Perry was one of the judges on the new incarnation of the singing competition TV show American Idol. In April 2025 Perry was one of six passengers on an all-female commercial spacecraft on Amazon founder Jeff Bezos’s Blue Origin rocket. During the 11-minute flight, Perry sang Louis Armstrong’s classic “What a Wonderful World” to her fellow space tourists, which included journalist Gayle King and former National Aeronautics and Space Administration rocket scientist Aisha Bowe. Following her marriage (2010–12) to Russell Brand, Perry became engaged to actor Orlando Bloom in 2018. Two years later, they had a daughter, John M. The album was not a success. At age 17 she moved to Los Angeles and collaborated with producer Glen Ballard, but was not able to secure a lasting record deal. Perry did sign to Columbia Records in 2004, but again this did not prove a success, and she was dropped.An executive at Columbia recommended Perry to the chairman of Virgin Records, Jason Flom, which resulted in her signing for Capitol Music Group. She recorded her second album, “One of the Boys” and in the Spring of 2008 released the lead single, the controversial “I Kissed a Girl”. The song proved a smash, hitting the number one slot in several countries. Other hit singles followed and the album was a commercial success.Perry was now established as a pop superstar and cemented her position with the release of her next album “Teenage Dreams”, which spawned more huge hits including “California Gurls” and “Firework”. Many awards and music industry records followed. In 2012 Perry made the move into movies, releasing the documentary feature film Katy Perry: Part of Me (2012). Katy has started her own record label called “Metamorphosis Music” and has signed her very first artist Ferras, who was signed to Capitol Records back in 2007 with Katy Perry. Her image radically changed by the time of her 2008 smash single “I Kissed a Girl,” from One of the Boys, and she went on to top the charts with the follow-up albums Teenage Dream, Prism and Witness. Perry is also known for her performance during the 2015 Super Bowl halftime show, her marriage to comedian Russell Brand and her selection as a judge for American Idol.Early Life and Musical AspirationsKaty Perry was born Kathryn Elizabeth Hudson was born on October 25, 1984, in Santa Barbara, California. Fans might be surprised to learn that the singer who writes about sexual exploration in “I Kissed a Girl” grew up in a very conservative family. Both of her parents are pastors, and they refused to let her listen to any rock or popular music. “The only things I was allowed to listen to were the Sister Act 1 and 2 soundtracks,” Perry told Entertainment Weekly. She and her two siblings were also not permitted to watch such cable channels as MTV and VH1. Perry started taking singing lessons around the age of 9 and learned to play guitar when she was 13. Around this time, she began rebelling against her strict upbringing by piercing her own nose. She soon became interested in pursuing a career in music. With her mother, Perry made several trips to Nashville to record a gospel album, Katy Hudson, which was released in 2001. “It reached literally maybe 100 people, and then the label went bankrupt,” Perry explained to Entertainment Weekly.As a teenager, Perry was exposed to other musical influences. One friend introduced her to the music of Queen, which remains one of her favorite groups. “I’m very inspired by Freddie Mercury and how flamboyant and theatrical he was,” she told fashion magazine VWD.In high school, she strove to be her own person, choosing not to limit herself to one social group. “I was a hop-around. I hung out with the rockabilly crew, the guys who were trying to be rappers, the funny kids,” she told Seventeen magazine. Focused on her music, Perry got her GED and moved to Los Angeles to work with producer and songwriter Glen Ballard, who had collaborated with such artists as Christina Aguilera and Alanis Morissette. She was only 17 years old at the time, and being on her own proved tough. “It was five years of living in L.A. with no money, writing bad checks, selling my clothes to make rent, [and] borrowing money,” she told Seventeen. Perry also experienced a string of disappointments before getting her big break. She and Ballard were unable to find a record company willing to take them on, and her 2004 collaboration with music producers-turned-performers The Matrix was scrapped shortly before the project was to be released. After having three record deals fall apart, Perry finally signed with Capitol Records in 2007.Albums and SongsOne of the BoysFollowing the November 2007 release of the single “Ur So Gay,” which caught the attention of Madonna, Perry saw her career take off with her next effort, “I Kissed a Girl.” The song hit the top of the charts in the summer of 2008, propelling Perry’s album, One of the Boys, into the Billboard Top 10. A follow-up single, “Hot n Cold,” also charted highly.Along with earning a Best Female Pop Vocal Performance Grammy nomination, Perry became famous for her theatricality. On the Warped Tour, she performed “I Kissed a Girl” with a giant tube of lip balm, referencing a line in the song. Perry has also jumped into a larger-than-life cake and appeared in a number of wild outfits while onstage. Describing her style as “Lucille Ball meets Bob Mackie,” she told Esquire, “It’s about innuendo. I want everybody to get the joke, but I want them to think about it for a minute.”In 2009, Perry appeared in her own acoustic special on MTV. The soundtrack from the show, Katy Perry: MTV Unplugged, was released around the same time.‘Teenage Dream’ Picking up where she left off, Perry released a new single with Snoop Dogg, “California Gurls,” in May 2010. The single shot to the top of the charts, paving the way for its accompanying studio album, Teenage Dream, to do the same. Perry’s follow-up singles, “Teenage Dream,” “Firework,” “E.T.,” and “Last Friday Night (T.G.I.F.)” all followed the path of “California Gurls,” making Perry just the second artist, after Michael Jackson, to have five No. 1 hits from a single album.In 2012, she released a new edition of her hit album, called Teenage Dream: The Complete Confection. The record had several new tracks, including the successful singles “Part of Me” and “Wide Awake.” ‘Prism’Perry continued to dominate the music charts with 2013’s Prism. The album’s lead single, “Roar,” climbed to No. 1, and “Dark Horse,” her collaboration with Juicy J, also spent several weeks in the top spot, pushing Perry past Mariah Carey for most total weeks with a No. 1 hit (46). The album’s fifth and final single, “This Is How We Do It,” featuring Riff Raff, also performed well.‘Witness’A few months after the release of “Chained to the Rhythm,” with Skip Marley, Perry dropped her latest studio effort, Witness, in June 2017. Witness debuted in the top spot, giving the artist her five credited co-writers and the four corporations that released and distributed “Dark Horse” all found liable for copyright infringement. The following month, Perry and her collaborators were ordered to pay \$2.78 million in compensation. However, the verdict was overturned upon appeal in March 2020, with a federal judge determining that the disputed portion of “Dark Horse” — an eight-note ostinato that runs through much of the song — was not distinctive enough to be protected by copyright laws.Movies and Other EndeavorsThe artist was the subject of the autobiographical documentary Katy Perry: Part of Me (2012), which featured behind-the-scenes footage and clips of young Perry along with her dazzling concert performances. She also voiced the character of Smurfette in The Smurfs (2011) and The Smurfs 2 (2013) and made a cameo as herself in Zoolander 2 (2016). In 2014, Perry also launched her own music label, Metamorphosis Music, as a subsidiary of Capitol. The label changed its name to Unsub Records in 2016. After visiting Madagascar on behalf of UNICEF in April 2013, Perry became a UNICEF Goodwill Ambassador later in the year. In February 2020, she was named an ambassador of the British Asian Trust by Britain’s Prince Charles. Personal LifeIn 2009, Perry made tabloid headlines for her relationship with British comedian Russell Brand. They were engaged over the New Year’s holiday while on a trip to India, and on October 23, 2010, the couple married in India in a traditional Hindu ceremony. According to The Times of India, the wedding featured a procession of camels, elephants and horses, plus fire jugglers, snake charmers, dancers and musicians. Their union, however, did not last long, as Brand filed for divorce in December 2011. Perry has also been romantically linked to musicians John Mayer and Diplo, as well as actor Orlando Bloom. On February 15, 2019, she announced her engagement to Bloom with an Instagram photo that showed her flower-shaped ring. Just after midnight on March 5, Perry delivered another surprise announcement by revealing a baby bump at the end of her new video for “Never Worn White.” What’s more, the video revealed that Perry and her partner of five years have split up. Rumors had circulated for a few weeks claiming that the couple was struggling in their relationship. Billboard has reached out to representatives for both Perry and Bloom for comment. In the meantime, Perry is currently finishing out the Australian leg of her tour before she returns to the United States in July to begin the second half of her North American tour. The two began dating in 2016 after meeting at that year’s Golden Globes (notably sharing a vape pen and sparking rumors as well as that cart), got engaged in 2019, and share a daughter, Daisy, born in 2020.Vanity Fair has reached out to Perry and Bloom and Perry for confirmation. Even with a one-year-ish breakup early on, you can’t deny that Bloom and Perry had quite the run.In 2020, the two had been set for a summer wedding in Japan, but the COVID-19 pandemic foiled their plans. Perry, who was pregnant with Daisy at the time, did not walk down the aisle as a third-trimester bride as she’d hoped, but was the recipient of one of Taylor Swift’s infamous baby gifts, in the form of a hand-embroidered blanket, which is almost as memorable. An unnamed source told Us Weekly this week that the former couple are “still very much in touch and co-parenting Daisy together,” with Bloom traveling to Australia to be with Perry and their daughter before he reportedly heads to Venice for the Bezos wedding extravaganza. “It’s not messy between them,” the source continued. “They aren’t making drastic changes for Daisy’s sake. They will keep their lives in Montecito. They are prioritizing stability and consistency for Daisy.” Their prior breakup, too, appeared amicable, with the exes often spending time together at public events. Both had been married and divorced previously: Bloom to model Miranda Kerr, and Perry to Russell Brand. Katy Perry and Orlando Bloom, who hit up the Vanity Fair Oscars party in March, have parted ways. Dating ensued.Bloom, 48, and Perry, 40, split up for about a year starting in 2017, but got engaged in 2019. Bloom and Perry are “in touch and coparenting,” according to an Us Weekly source, and will continue living in the Montecito area so their daughter has stability. The outlet reported that the two split up in April, before Perry’s Lifestyles Tour kicked off.Then on Thursday, TMZ spotted the “Lord of the Rings” actor alone in Venice, chatting up some Kardashians and other guests ahead of billionaire Bezos’ wedding to Lauren Sanchez. Looks like he got custody of the invitation. A source connected to Perry told Us Weekly recently that the singer, whose marriage to Russell Brand ended in 2011, was “upset but relieved to not have to go through another divorce, as that was the worst time in her life.” In addition to Perry, Bloom has a son, Flynn, with ex-wife and model Kerr.Times staff writer Alexandra Del Rosario contributed to this article.
