JAMB Change of Course and Institution for 2021/2022 Academic Session has Commenced!!! This is to inform all candidates who participated in the 2021 JAMB UTME that the change of JAMB course and/or institution for the 2021/2022 Academic Session has started. The change of institution and course is introduced to enable JAMB candidates who already know their scores and have verified the cut-off mark of their choice institutions to make the necessary changes in their choice of course and institution relative to their UTME scores. If you scored below 180 in the JAMB 2021 Examination and you choose a competitive Institution like University of Ilorin, UNILORIN, University of Benin, UNIBEN, then you can now apply for a less competitive one to increase your chances of admission. Or if you chose a popular/competitive course like Surgery and Medicine, Accounting, etc., And you scored 199 and below, then you really need to apply for a change of course and/or institution. Before you proceed, please read this information carefully. You will not be able to correct any mistake you made hereafter. All interested candidates should know the changes of Course and/or Institution you would like to make changes to. You are advised to do your own due diligence to ensure that the school you are changing to, is not on the high side when it comes to cut-off marks. You can change one or all your courses/institutions at the same time. You should note that once the form is submitted, you will NOT be able to make any changes again (unless Jamb has updated this). Candidates should opt for a course/Institution that aligns with their subject combination. If you don't do this, your school will screen you out. Check Jamb Syllabus for more info on this. Most schools have a lot of candidates already, like the University of Ilorin. So be sure you have up to 2 to 4 options. Just in case, your preferred choice is not available, you can take the next option. The JAMB change of course scratch card is sold at the rate of Two Thousand Five Hundred Naira (N2,500.00) only. Click Here for Update Jamb Change of Course/Institution Closing Date. To modify your course or institution with JAMB, first go to the portal and login. Select "Registration" and then "2025 UTME Data Correction". Make a payment, then select "Pay Now", and note the Transaction ID as it will be useful for future referrals. Follow the instructions on the Confirmation Page again and pay using your Mastercard or Visa. After making this change, you can see your Transaction ID **bold red font**. You will need to pay for an opportunity to fill in change of university form. You may pay immediately with your card, or pay in some ATM. If you choose the latter, you need to provide your Transaction ID. If you want to pay on the website, enter your card details and make payment. If it is successful, you will see the following options - Year of Exam and JAMB Registration Number. When you have entered this data, you will see new options for Preferred course/Institution. After submitting all the changes, JAMB change of course form will close. If your changes are approved, they will update quickly. Please Note: JAMB change of course/institution can only be done once and you can only change to a course relating to your UTME Subject combination. To know if the course you want to change to aligns with your UTME subject combination, Click Here. Candidates should also note that changes for Course/Institution Names, Date of Birth, Gender, State/LGA of Origin are N2,500 (two thousand five hundred naira only). Frequently Asked Questions: Can I still change my course on JAMB portal? JAMB 2024 students will only be able to apply for Change of Course in JAMB immediately after the release of the results. This means, after the 2024 JAMB UTME you will be able to change your old course to a new one on JAMB Portal. What is the deadline for change of institution? Usually, there is no set date by the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board as the closing date for change of courses or change of institutions. How much does it cost to change course and institution? The Change of Course/Institution is N2,500 (two thousand five hundred naira only). Payment can be done online using your cards, simply login to your jamb profile and follow the procedure outlined here. How do I know if my JAMB change of course was successful? How do I know if my JAMB change of institution was successful? To confirm if your JAMB change of institution was successful, simply login to your JAMB Profile using your Username and Password @ Click on Check admission status and then access my JAMB CAPS. How many times does JAMB allow change of institution? JAMB allows two-time changes to be made to a candidate's institutions and/or courses. However, there is more to know regarding this. It would take a few days to about a week for your changes on the JAMB portal to reflect on your profile and register for the Post UTME screening. However, a question remains: What is the financial implication of such alterations? What are the costs associated with changing institutions and/or courses on the JAMB portal? In this article, I will not only provide you with the required fees for changing institutions, but I will also clarify whether a single payment covers alterations for both institutions and courses or if separate payments are necessary. Furthermore, I will detail additional expenses you might encounter while completing these changes. JAMB's Official Fee for Changing Institutions is N2500. The official fee stipulated for effecting changes in your chosen institutions is N2500. Fortunately, if you intend to modify more than one institution (as there are a total of four), the same N2500 covers all the alterations. Upon payment by the CBT center, an amount of two thousand five hundred naira will be debited from your account or the CBT center's account (not individual accounts). This transaction will be carried out online, right on the JAMB portal, and via the Remita platform or other included payment platforms. JAMB's Official Fee for Changing Courses is Also N2,500. For changing institutions, if you intend to alter a single course, the cost is N2,500. If you plan to modify multiple or all courses, the same N2,500 suffices for all changes. Payment for Both Institutions and Courses Still Costs N2500 in Total. When you decide to simultaneously change both your institution (s) and course (s), the payment required by JAMB remains N2500 in total. This means that if you need to modify two institutions and two courses, or any other combination of institutions and courses, you will still have to pay N2,500. The JAMB fee for changing institutions and courses remains N2500, regardless of how many changes are made. You can apply for a Change of Course through JAMB's process, which includes completing the JAMB exams and receiving your results. This is your last chance to adjust your academic path. This serves as proof that you have made the change. Keep it safe. The Cost: How Much is the JAMB Change of Course Form in 2025? Knowing the price will prevent overcharging. The total fee consists of two parts. The official JAMB fee for changing your course/institution is N2,500. The CBT centre fee, which is usually around ₦1,000, adds to the overall cost. You should anticipate paying a total of about ₦3,500. How Long Does it Take for the Change to Show? The change is not immediate. It can take anywhere from 24 hours to several weeks to appear on the JAMB portal. Be patient. How to Check Your Admission on JAMB CAPS After the change shows, check your admission status regularly on the JAMB CAPS portal. This is where you will accept or decline your admission. Go to efacility.jamb.gov.ng and log in with your email and password. Click "Check Admission Status." Enter your JAMB Reg No. and select your exam year. Click "Access my CAPS." If you have an admission offer, click "Accept" or "Reject." Note: Failing to accept on CAPS doesn't mean you have declined the admission, even if the school offered it to you. To change your course in JAMB, ensure you're certain about the institution and course you want to switch to. Use the JAMB brochure to confirm the course is offered at the school. Confirm the school's cut-off score isn't higher than yours. Align your chosen course with your JAMB combination of subjects. You can switch both universities and courses at once for a N3,500 fee. Make one-time corrections for name, date of birth, passport, gender, state/LGA, or Institution/Course selections. Adjustment of your JAMB profile costs N3,500. Download the Exam Scholars 2025 CBT app on Windows, Android, or iOS for more info. After admission, some people may secure a course but dislike it. In Nigerian universities, changing courses is permitted but only downward, not upward. You won't get better courses when changing; instead, you'll get lower-rated ones. The JAMB change of course process is for applicants who want to change their course due to various reasons. The fee for this process is N2,500 plus an additional N700 service fee, totaling N3,200. Requirements include a valid JAMB registration number, biometric capture, and login details. Follow the steps to change your course on the JAMB portal. Clicking on Correction of data will display options such as "Change of Course/Institution", "Change of Name", etc. For a course change, select "Year of Examination" and "Registration Number". Proceed with payment and confirm details to obtain a Transaction ID, which will be sent via email and SMS. After paying, re-enter exam year and registration number before selecting preferred courses. Submit the application for JAMB to process it. You can apply for a course change in JAMB twice in an exam year, but after that you cannot apply again. Yes, you can still apply to change your course after accepting admission on JAMB CAPS if you were admitted to study a different course from the one you applied for. After completing one year of studies, you can apply for transfer by submitting an application or relocating to another university, but you cannot use JAMB for this. If you did not meet the cut-off mark for your first chosen course and wrote the post-UTME exam, you can still change your course after that. Originally, it was possible to change courses using your phone at CBT centres, but now correction of data such as changing courses is only available at accredited JAMB Centres. You cannot complete this application at a cyber café or unaccredited centre. The deadline for applying for a course change in JAMB has not been set yet for students who registered and took the exam this year, while those who have passed previous exams are no longer eligible to apply for a course change.
