

The first grunge sounds came out of Seattle in the mid-1980s, but it really gained popularity in the early and mid-1990s. This subgenre of rock music was a sensation. Bands like Nirvana, Pearl Jam, Soundgarden and Stone Temple Pilots broke through and showed the world that there was a type of rock music that wasn't necessarily metal and not necessarily psychedelic.
