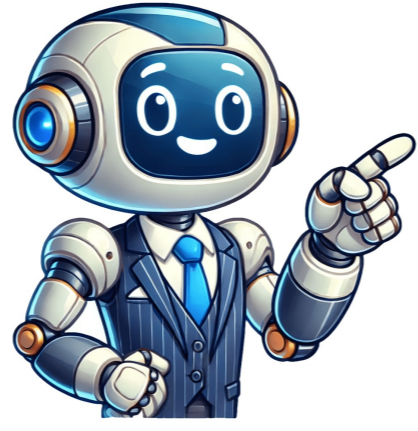

Instead of hunching over your keyboard or increasing the monitors brightness, so you can see what key you're pressing, you can turn on your keyboard's backlight. However, different apps, software updates, or hardware issues might stop your backlit keyboard from working. So if you've already restarted your computer or connected your keyboard to a different USB port, and it still isn't working, it's time you take a closer look at the problem. Check Your Keyboard Connections Backlighting features are controlled by software, and they can sometimes be disabled by accident. If you've accidentally disabled the feature, the same goes for your wireless laptop. Go to the manufacturer's website to find product descriptions for the keyboard you want to use. Looking for a minimalist problem? You may have plugged the wrong cable into the back of the keyboard. The connector of the cable must match the connector on the keyboard. If the backlight doesn't turn on, we have listed below some things that might help. Some of them might be complicated, but well walk you through the steps. There's a chance you've set the brightness level too low, so check to make a difference after you turn on the keyboard backlight. The fastest way to increase the brightness level is to use your keyboard. Look for the key with the backlight icon and press it two or three times in a row. If you've found the backlight icon, but it doesn't work, press the Fn key at the same time. When dealing with a backlit keyboard that's not working, it might be difficult to figure out if it's a hardware or software issue. So, before taking a look at your system settings, rule out any problem regarding the hardware. Reconnect the keyboard. If it's a Bluetooth keyboard, turn off Bluetooth for a few moments and turn it back on. Plug the keyboard into a different USB port. If its backlight feature is now working, you'll have to fix a malfunctioning USB port. Take a look at the keyboard cable and search for any damage. If your laptop has a built-in backlit keyboard, check its app. Most of the time, the app will get installed at the same time as the keyboard drivers, but this may vary, depending on the manufacturer. Also, if you've connected an external keyboard that comes with the backlit feature, you should take a look at the app. Check the keyboard settings within the app and make sure everything is as you want. Also, go to the producers website and update the app to the latest version. Even if you've made the right system settings, a third-party keyboard app may overwrite them, so it's worth checking it out. If your keyboard's backlight is sensor-activated, and it doesn't work anymore, there's a chance an outdated or corrupt driver is causing the problem. To fix it, you should update your keyboard driver. Here is how you can do that: Press Windows + X to open the Device Manager. Under Keyboards, click on the arrow to expand the list. Right-click on the keyboard you want to update the driver for. Select Update driver. Follow the prompts to install the latest driver. If the keyboard still doesn't work, try updating the BIOS. Press Win + I to open Windows Settings. Select Update & Security and head to Troubleshoot. Additional troubleshooters From Find and fix other problems under Keyboard. In Windows 11, go to Settings > System > Troubleshoot. Under troubleshooters to access the Keyboard troubleshooter. Once Windows finishes the troubleshooting process, try to turn on or adjust the brightness of your backlit keyboard. If it didn't work, there's another troubleshooter you should run. While Microsoft removed it from the Settings menu, you can still access it using a Command Prompt line. Follow these steps to run the Hardware and Devices troubleshooter: Open Command Prompt with administrative rights. Type msdsc.exe -id DeviceDiagnostic and press Enter. In the Hardware and Devices window, click Advanced and check Apply repairs automatically. Click Next to run the troubleshooter. If nothing worked until now, you should perform a clean boot on your computer. This way, your system will start without any third-party app that might influence your backlit keyboard functionality. If your keyboard lights up, open Control Panel and take a look at the apps that you've installed lately since one of them is causing your problem. The goal is to open the Control Panel so that you can uninstall the program.Here, you will see a list of software, and from the list, you have to find Logitech Software. Once you get it, you have to take your cursor on the software and right-click there. In the drop-down menu, you will see several options along with Uninstall.Click on Uninstall to remove the software. It will take a bit of time, wait for it. When it is completed, make sure you have removed the receiver thats connected to your computer.Once the uninstallation process is done, you have to restart your computer so that Windows can save the recent changes you have made. Now, you need to reinstall the program.After the reboot, plug in the receiver in the USB port of your PC. When you do this, Windows will show you a prompt and will tell you to install the driver. There will be several on-screen instructions given, all you need is to follow them and install the software.Now that the program is installed once again, the bug will be fixed and you will be able to use your Logitech k800 keyboard without any complication.Another way to fix the problem if the previous solution didnt work is via reinstalling the Logitech keyboard driver. This method works with k800 along with k360, k470, and k270 models.But if you own an mk320, you can take a look at how you can fix the Logitech mk320 keyboard not working too! Lets get back to fixing k800!Firstly, you have to go through the Windows Icon at the bottom left part of your PC or the Start Menu. Click on it and several options will be available, among them; you have to choose Device Manager.When the Device Manager appears on the screen, you will see a list of all the installed drivers. In the list, search for the one with Keyboard. Once you get it, click on it.When you click on the Keyboard, you will be able to see the Logitech Wireless Keyboard Driver. All you need to do is uninstall it. Select the Uninstall Device option and then, take your cursor to the Uninstall button. Once the driver is uninstalled, you have to restart your computer.While the computer will go through the restarting process, the computer will find out which driver is missing and as it is an essential driver, the PC will itself install the necessary keyboard driver.However, we recommend you check if the driver is installed or not. Go through the Device Manager after the reboot and check for the installed drivers. If you dont find it there, you have to go for the Action menu.There, settle for the option- Scan for Hardware Changed. And then, you will be able to see the driver! This process of installing the driver again will fix the keyboard.At times, you might see the driver with a Yellow Exclamation Mark. If you see this, go through the next steps to fix it.Here, take your cursor to the driver and then right-click the mark. You will see an option named Update Driver. Select it and then pick up Search for the Drivers Automatically. With a consistent internet connection, your computer will search for the necessary driver/Once the search process is done, the computer will update it. Now, once again, select Action and then scan for the hardware change. A refreshed list will appear and you will see the keyboard driver there!Almost all of the Logitech wireless keyboard k800 issues will be fixed if you follow these methods.
