## Bob the builder characters scarecrow

Appearance Spud is a living (presumably mutated) Australian-British scarecrow that wears a lavender shirt with a red and green scarf, blue trousers, a brown belt and he has a sharp cone-shaped replaceable parsnip nose which has been bent by accident twice. Personality Spud is a mischievous scarecrow who often causes more problems than he solves, but usually everything works out in the end. It's Spud who needs to learn to be patient, not to eat all of the food, not to take things from other characters, etc. Spud has a habit of trying to do work and, with his limited intelligence, getting it wrong and spoiling materials. Squawk is his rival. But in the later seasons of the Original Series from seasons 6-9, Spud's voice sounds very similar to Zippy from Rainbow. This also continues in Project: Build It and Ready, Steady, Build! Spud is the only character who's been in jail (though it was only in Muck's daydream). This was featured in the special, Built To Be Wild (2006). In "Bob's Boots" (Season 3), it was revealed that Spud does not like cheese and chutney in the United Kingdom dub. This was changed to peanut butter and jelly in the United States dub. In "Bob's Pizza" (Season 6), it was revealed that Spud's favourite pizza has apple, turnip and jam on it, which he calls "The Spud Special". Until "Scoop Has Some Fun" (Season 3), Lofty was afraid of him. Spud appeared only a few times in the first season of Ready, Steady, Build!, but appears in every episode from the two mini series. As for now, Spud is one of the few long time characters who never received a redesigned counterpart for the 2015 reboot along with Bird, Travis and Scruffy. In the Original Series between Seasons 1-9, he spoke with an American accent in the US dub. It is currently unknown why Alan Marriott didn't continue voicing Spud in 2005 to 2009 in the US dub as he still remained voicing Scoop and Travis in the series. In the Finnish version, Spud is called "Putte". In the Slovenian version, Spud is simply called "Pepi" which is common countryside name in Slovenia. It is very similar to the Slovene version of the first name of farmer Pickles, which is "Pepe". Spud's name is another word for "Potato". Spud is the only character in the Bob the Builder series to be a typically inanimate object. In Snowed Under: Bobblesberg Winter Games, it was revealed that Spud had a crush on Charlene. In the 'Official Children in Need Medley' music video, Spud was seen in a beach scene at sunset along with Bob, Wendy, Scoop and Pilchard and several non-Bob the Builder characters during the medley's 'Hey Jude' and 'One Day Like This' parts. He is the only character to fart in Bob the Builder. More Bob The Builder Wiki "Can we fix it?" "Yes we can!" Bob the Builder ( Bob-The-Builder-Posters.jpg)Bob the Builder is the main character of the popular TV show "Bob the Builder," which targets an audience of preschoolers. He goes around helping people do jobs such as building walls, mending fences, etc. He is assisted by Scoop, Muck, Dizzy, and Roley, all of whom are talking work-vehicles. Wendy is a blond female construction worker, and she has a blue crane named Lofty. I think that Bob and Wendy are in love and will be married some time in the future. Other major characters include Spud, an innocent scarecrow, and Pilchard, Bob's pet cat. The personalities and physical traits of the characters in Bob the Builder vary greatly. Wendy is a female construction worker. She is Bob's business partner and often helps him with his jobs. Scoop is a bright yellow backhoe loader. He is of the male gender and is quite confident, the self-proclaimed leader of the machines. Sometimes he can be quite bossy. His catchphrase is "No prob, Bob!" Muck is a red bulldozer. He is an impulsive male who does many things without thinking them over first, which sometimes gets him in trouble, though he always ends up O.K. His catchphrase is "Muck to the rescue!" Dizzy is a young, female, orange concrete mixer. She is eager to learn and easily excited. Her catchphrase is "Brilliant!" Roley is a male green steamroller. His catchphrase is "Rock and roll!" Lofty is a blue male crane. He is shy with little confidence, and his catchphrase is "Uhh...yeah, I think so!" He usually says this after Bob asks if they can fix it. Spud is a male scarecrow. In the TV show, he acts similar to a young child. His catchphrase is: "Ok, Farmer Pickles!" and "Spud's on the job!" Pilchard is Bob's female pet cat. She is quite lazy, and spends most of her time asleep.Bob the Builder is my hero because he is so determined. Once he starts doing a job, he never stops until he is finished, either ignoring or overcoming any obstacles in his way, be it sickness, bad weather, injuries, or someone with a bad attitude problem. He shows people, not only preschoolers, around the world that no matter what is in your way, if you give something enough effort, it is possible. He proves to us that there is no such thing as "Mission Impossible."Also, Bob shows us the power of teamwork. With his friends, Wendy, Scoop, Muck, Dizzy, Roley, Lofty, and more, he can do almost anything. Without them, many of the jobs he was given would not be able to be done. And that is why Bob the Builder is my hero.
